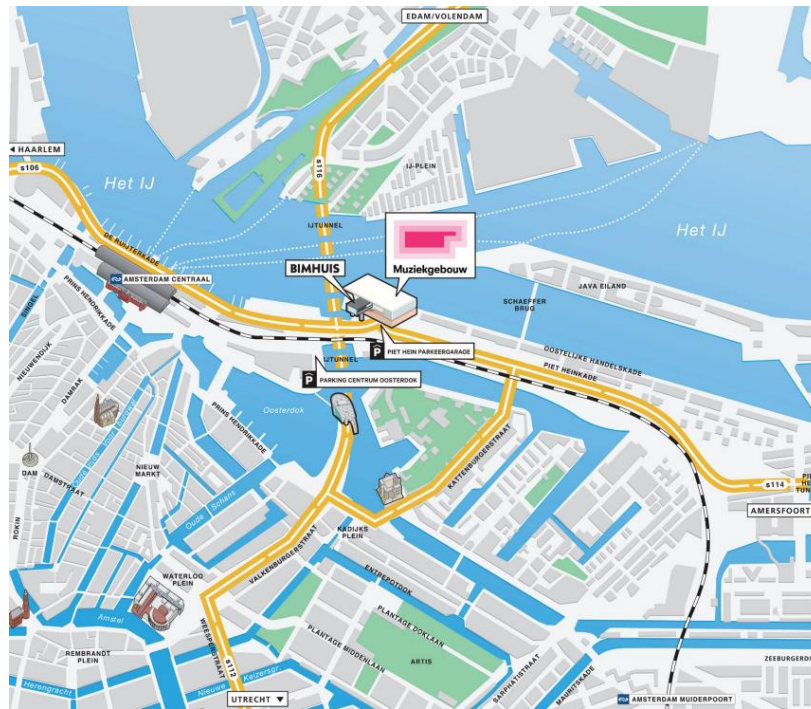


## How to get to the meeting

### Get directions and show routes

Muziekgebouw aan 't IJ in Amsterdam is easily accessible by both car and public transport. It is close to the Central Train Station of Amsterdam. Amsterdam Airport Schiphol is just thirty minutes by train.

### Public transport

- **Tram 26, stop Muziekgebouw**  
Disabled people are advised not to take the steep footbridge, but to enter the Muziekgebouw through the main entrance at the bottom of the quay. You reach the main entrance by going 75 metres to the right of the bridge, following the road down around the little harbour, past the Mövenpick Hotel.
- **By foot**  
About a 15-minute walk from Central Station. Leave the station via exit Noord (towards the IJ). Outside, turn right and follow the waterfront. At the traffic lights (after 300 m) go straight on, following the main road uphill. You will see Muziekgebouw aan 't IJ on your left
- **By bicycle**  
Underneath Muziekgebouw aan 't IJ is a bicycle shed (free of charge, open 24 hours a day). You can reach the parking via a roller conveyor right in front of the main entrance.

## How to get to the meeting

From the bicycle shed you can go inside to the entrance hall/box office of Muziekgebouw aan 't IJ.

- **By car**

From the A10 eastern ring road, exit S114 towards Centrum, via the Piet Hein tunnel.

From Haarlem, follow the S102.

### **Parking your car**

Right below the Muziekgebouw, you can park in the Piet Heingarage of the Municipality of Amsterdam. From the car park, the Entrance Hall can be reached by lift or stairs. Alternative, nearby parking garages are Parking Centrum Oosterdok on Oosterdokskade and P+R Zeeburg
